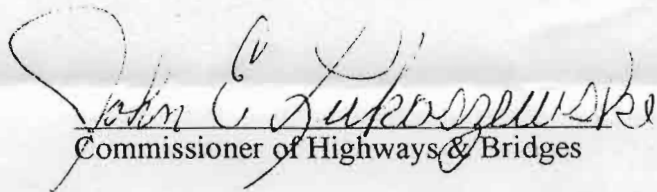
THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned Commissioner of Highways & Bridges, having jurisdiction of the Town and County Bridges of the County of Ulster, does hereby close the bridge known as;

County Bridge #131, DeWitt Bridge
In the Town of Rochester in said County of Ulster

County Bridge #131, DeWitt Bridge located on DeWitt Road crossing the Mettakahonts Creek in the Town of Rochester will be closed to all traffic effective Monday November 28, 2005 to facilitate the replacement of the existing structure. Traffic may use Queens Highway west 1.30 miles to Samsonville Road, Samsonville Road north 2.00 miles to Brown Road, Brown Road southeast 0.60 miles to DeWitt Road.

The necessity for such closing consists of the fact that such bridge is a COUNTY bridge and is being closed under authority vested by Section 231 of the Highway Law.
