RECYCLING MADE EASY

“Ulster County Recycles” recycling instructions

MIXED PAPER PRODUCTS BIN

(only corrugated cardboard/brown paper bags need be separated)

NOTE: Flatten Cardboard.

DO NOT tie together, keep loose.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Newspapers
Magazines and Catalogs
Computer/Copy/Fax paper
Writing/Ledger paper
Phonebooks
Junk Mail (including envelopes, coupons, ads, and inserts)
Paperback Books
Shiny/Glossy Paper
Wrapping Paper
Greeting Cards
ALL Thin cardboard (including cereal, pasta, cracker, and other food boxes, shoe boxes, tissue boxes, paper egg cartons, soda and beer packaging, toilet tissue and paper towel tubes)

NOT ACCEPTED

Waxed or Plastic Coated Paper/Boxes
Food Contaminated material
Pizza Boxes
Carbon Paper
"TyVek" or Non-tearable Envelopes
Paper Towels, Facial Tissues, Napkins, Paper Plates or Cups
Foil Wrapping Paper

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD BIN

NOTE: Flatten Cardboard.

DO NOT tie together, keep loose.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Corrugated Cardboard
Brown Paper Bags

NOT ACCEPTED

All other cardboard goes in the Mixed Paper Bin

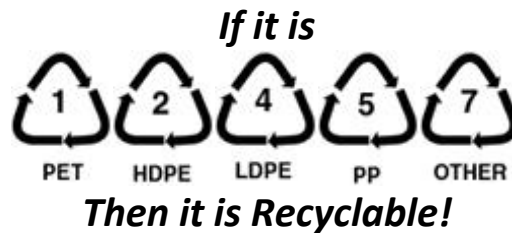
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COMINGLED PRODUCTS BIN (Tin Cans and Plastic Bottles)

NOTE: Remove Caps
Lids ARE acceptable
Rinse All Containers

Look for the code on the bottom of the container



ACCEPTABLE ITEMS	NOT ACCEPTED
Aluminum Cans	Aluminum Foil
Tin Cans/Containers	Plastic Bags
Aluminum or Tin Can Tops and Bottoms	Prescription Bottles
Metal Jar Lids	Foil or Pie Plates
Plastic Bottles (like shampoo, water, soda) REMOVE CAPS, PLEASE!	Plastic Food Wrap
Plastic Tubs (like yogurt, cottage cheese) LIDS ARE OKAY!	Snack or Sandwich Bags
Plastic Jugs (like milk, juice)	Microwavable Food Trays
	Styrofoam
	Automotive Fluid Bottles
	Plastic Bottles that held Chemicals
	Herbicide/Pesticide Containers
	Plastic Toys
	Pots, Pans, or other Metal Cookware

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GLASS BIN

NOTE: Remove Caps and Lids

Rinse All Containers

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS	NOT ACCEPTED
Glass Bottles	Light Bulbs
Glass Jars	Flower Vases
	Drinking Glasses
	Window Glass
	Ovenware
	Mirrors
	Non-Container Glass
	Ceramics or Dishes
	Pyrex

SCRAP METAL BIN

The Transfer Station accepts just about everything metal that is found in a normal household.

No transformers or chemical containers

Accepted at No charge

C&D BIN

Most items that are found in a normal household are accepted.

Paint will only be accepted in a solid state.

Rates are \$.05/lb. or \$100/ton

Brush/Trees/Yard Waste

No piece over 6 ft. long or 6 ft. wide.

Brush will only be accepted up to 4 in. in diameter.

No charge to Transfer Station Permit Holders.

Mulch is available sometimes to residents

Propane Canisters

May be dropped off at No Charge

Tires

Up to 16" at a rate of \$1.75 per tire

Larger (no tires larger than tandem trailer size) at a rate of \$15.00 per tire

Appliances

Any appliance without Freon is accepted for free.

Appliances with Freon are accepted at a rate of \$12.25 ea.

"Free Stuff" Area

The Transfer Station has an area set up for residents to drop off good condition items which they no longer want, need, or have use for which might be able to be used by others.

Please, no books.

Unwanted Clothing

Drop off in the marked bins. Please bag.

ITEMS WHICH CANNOT BE ACCEPTED AT THE TRANSFER STATION
